

AN ORDINANCE to appoint a person for the purposes of the 26th Section of the Constitution and the 39th Section of the "Church of England Trust Property Act 1917."

WHEREAS by the 26th Section of the Constitutions contained in the Schedule to the "Church of England Constitutions Act Amendment Act of 1902" under certain circumstances during certain periods the powers by the said Constitutions vested in the Archbishop of the Diocese are to be exercised by the person appointed for the purpose by an Ordinance of Synod AND WHEREAS by the 39th Section of the "Church of England Trust Property Act 1917" (No. 21) under certain circumstances and during certain periods the powers functions and things referred to in the said Act or some of them are to be exercised done or made by the person appointed for the purpose by an Ordinance of Synod in the place of the Archbishop The Synod of the Diocese of Sydney in pursuance of the powers in that behalf conferred upon it by the said Constitutions and Acts and of all other powers thereto enabling it ordains and declares as follows that is to say:—

1. The person who shall be elected by ballot at the present Session of Synod and thereafter at the first Session of each succeeding Synod is hereby appointed as the person by whom under the said circumstances and during the said periods the said powers are to be exercised in pursuance of the said 26th Section of the said Constitutions and as the person by whom the said powers functions and things are to be exercised done or made in pursuance of the said 39th Section of the said Act.

2. Nominations for the election above referred to shall be made on the first day of such Session any time prior to 9 p.m. If only one person be nominated such person shall be declared duly elected. If more than one but not more than two persons be nominated a ballot shall take place on the third day of such Session as provided for in the Standing Orders. If more than two persons be nominated, an exhaustive ballot shall be taken at such Session until only one name is left and the person whose name is left shall be declared duly elected.

3. The provisions of the "Ordinance for the appointment of Archbishops to the See of Sydney 1900" shall not be deemed to operate as an appointment of a person for the purposes aforesaid and the said Ordinance shall be read subject to the pro-

visions of the said Constitutions and the said Act and this Ordinance.
