
The Cathedral Ordinance of 1902 Amendment Ordinance of 1932.

No. 7, 1932.

AN ORDINANCE to further amend the Cathedral Ordinance of 1902 and for other purposes.

WHEREAS it is expedient to provide that the Bishop Coadjutor of the Diocese of Sydney shall ex officio and while holding the said office be a member of the Chapter of the Cathedral Church of Saint Andrew Sydney and the Synod of the Diocese in pursuance of the powers conferred upon it by the Constitutions for the management and good government of the Church of England within the State of New South Wales and of all other powers in the said Synod ordains and rules as follows:—

1. The Cathedral Ordinance of 1902 is hereby amended by the insertion after Clause 10 of the said Ordinance of the following clause:—

10a—The Bishop Coadjutor of Sydney shall by virtue of his office and while holding the same be a member of the Chapter with the rights and privileges of a Clerical Canon of the said Chapter and shall under this Ordinance take precedence next after the Dean of Sydney.

2. This Ordinance may be cited as "The Cathedral Ordinance of 1902 Amendment Ordinance of 1932."
