

"Glebe Administration Further Amendment Ordinance 1937."

No. 13, 1937.

AN ORDINANCE to further amend and supplement the Glebe Administration Ordinance 1930 (No. 15 of 1930) and to provide for a special assessment from the parishes and districts within the Diocese of Sydney and for other purposes.

WHEREAS by clause 14 of the Glebe Administration Ordinance 1930 (hereinafter referred to as the Principal Ordinance) provision is made for the application of the rents issues and profits of St. Philip's Glebe.

AND WHEREAS the Principal Ordinance was amended by the Glebe Administration Amendment Ordinance 1935 and by the Glebe Administration Further Amendment Ordinance No. 2 of 1936 and by the Glebe Administration Further Amendment Ordinance No. 11 of 1936.

AND WHEREAS by reason of circumstances subsequent to the creation of the trusts to which the said rents issues and profits are subject it is expedient to vary such trusts in manner hereinafter mentioned and to make further provisions as hereinafter contained.

AND WHEREAS the Synod of the Diocese of Sydney on the Twenty-third day of September 1936 adopted an assessment for Registry and Synod Assessment to take effect from the 1st April 1937 until the 31st March 1940 in accordance with the provisions of "The Registry and Synod Assessments Ordinance 1895" and "The Registry and Synod Assessments Amendment Ordinance of 1896."

AND WHEREAS it is expedient that a separate assessment be made on the basis of the aforesaid assessment for the purpose of assisting to provide adequate allowances to widows and children of the Clergy of the Diocese of Sydney.

Now the Synod of the Diocese of Sydney ordains directs declares and rules as follows:—

1. By reason of circumstances subsequent to the creation of the trusts to which the said rents issues and profits of St. Philip's Glebe are subject it has become inexpedient to carry out or observe such trusts in so far as the same are hereby varied.

2. The Principal Ordinance as amended is hereby further amended by inserting at the end of sub-clause (k) of clause 14 the following new sub-clause:—

(kk) In paying to the Archbishop a sum not exceeding Five hundred pounds to be applied by him for the maintenance benefit or advancement in life of widows and children of deceased clergy of the Diocese of Sydney.

3. A fund shall be created to be called "The Clergy Widows' and Children's Fund" which shall be administered by the Archbishop.

4. An assessment in accordance with the particulars as set out in the attached schedule shall take effect as from the 1st April 1937 and shall remain in force until the 31st March 1940.

5. Contributions under clause 4 of this Ordinance shall be held to be due and payable on the 1st October 1937 and thereafter on the 1st April 1938 and 1939 shall be paid to the Archbishop to be placed by him to the credit of the fund referred to in clause 3 and shall be administered in like manner as set out in clause 2 of this ordinance.

6. For the purposes of this Ordinance "Archbishop" shall mean the Archbishop for the time being of the Diocese of Sydney or the person for the time being entitled to exercise the powers vested in the Archbishop by the Constitution.

7. This Ordinance shall remain in force until the 31st March 1940 except in so far as the administration of the funds then in the hands of the Archbishop.

8. This Ordinance shall be cited as the "Glebe Administration Further Amendment Ordinance 1937."
