
Glebe Administration Ordinance 1930-1965
Amendment Ordinance 1966

No. 16, 1966.

AN ORDINANCE to amend Clause 14 (2) of the Glebe Administration Ordinance 1930-1965 and for purposes incidental thereto.

WHEREAS by the Glebe Administration Ordinance 1930-1965 provision is made by Clause 14 (2) thereof to apply the rents issues and profits of St. Philip's Glebe in a certain manner and as to the remainder of the said rents issues and profits for such purposes as shall be determined by Synod AND WHEREAS it is expedient to apply portion of the said remainder for or towards the purposes and to the extent hereafter set out NOW therefore the Standing Committee of the Synod of the Diocese of Sydney in the name and place of the said Synod and by virtue of the powers vested in it pursuant to the Church of England (Bodies Corporate) Act 1938 Delegation of Powers Ordinance 1961 and all other powers thereunto it enabling hereby ORDAINS RULES AND DIRECTS as follows:-

1. This Ordinance may be cited as "Glebe Administration Ordinance 1930-1965 Amendment Ordinance 1966."

2. The "Glebe Administration Ordinance 1930-1965" is in this Ordinance referred to as "the Principal Ordinance."

3. Clause 14 (2) of the Principal Ordinance is amended by inserting after sub-clause (q6) the following sub-clause:-

"(q7) In setting aside a sum not exceeding Eighteen thousand dollars (\$18,000) for the use of the Standing Committee to be applied by it towards the General Assessment Budget for the year ending 31st March, 1967."

4. The provisions contained in the preceding clause shall operate for a term of one year but they or any of them may be extended from time to time and for such time as Standing Committee may by resolution determine.
