
Ingleburn Sale and Purchase Amendment.

AN ORDINANCE to amend the "St. James' Church Ingleburn Sale and Purchase Ordinance of 1916."

WHEREAS in the above mentioned Ordinance it was erroneously stated that the land described in the second part of the Schedule of the said Ordinance was vested in the Church of England Property Trust Diocese of Sydney AND WHEREAS in fact Samuel George Barff Thomas Latty and Joseph Whitehouse were then the Trustees of the said land AND WHEREAS the Synod of the Diocese of Sydney has by resolution declared that vacancies exist in the whole of the membership of the said Trust and has appointed the Church of England Property Trust Diocese of Sydney Trustees of the said land Now therefore the Synod of the Diocese of Sydney in pursuance of the powers in that behalf conferred upon it by the Constitutions for the management and good government of the Church of England in the State of New South Wales and of the powers of the said Church of England Trust Property Act 1917 ordains and rules as follows:—

1. The Church of England Property Trust may now lawfully act upon and carry into effect the provisions of the said "St. James' Church Ingleburn Sale and Purchase Ordinance of 1916" in respect of the said land.

2. This Ordinance may be cited as the "St. James' Church Ingleburn Sale and Purchase Amendment Ordinance 1921."
