No. 22, 1950.

AN ORDINANCE to amend "The Registry and Synod Assessments Ordinance 1895-1949."

The Synod of the Diocese of Sydney ordains directs declares and rules as follows:—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the "Registry and Synod Assessments Amendment Ordinance of 1950."

2. The Registry and Synod Assessments Ordinance 1895-1949 is in this Ordinance referred to as the Principal Ordinance.

3. The Principal Ordinance as amended by this Ordinance may be cited as the "Registry and Synod Assessments Ordinance 1895-1950."

4. The Principal Ordinance is amended:—

- (a) By suspending so much of the provisions of such Ordinance as are inconsistent with this Ordinance and by fixing an assesment for the purposes referred to in such Ordinance for the year commencing on the first day of April, 1951, and ending on the thirty-first day of March, 1952.
  - (b) The Synod hereby fixes an assessment of £8168 8s. 6d. for the period of one year from the first day of April, 1951, to the thirty-first day of March, 1952, in accordance with the Schedule hereto.
  - (c) Contributions under this Ordinance shall be held to be due on the first day of April, 1951, and shall be paid to the Standing Committee on or before the thirtieth day of June, 1951.
