No. 32, 1966.

AN ORDINANCE to amend the Special Purposes Assessment Ordinance 1958.

WHEREAS it is expedient to continue the provisions of the Special Purposes Assessment Ordinance 1958 as amended (hereinafter called the Principal Ordinance) subject to certain amendments as hereinafter provided and to fix an assessment in pursuance thereof for one year to take effect from the 1st day of April, 1967 AND WHEREAS for the said year an estimated amount of \$95,900 will be required in accordance with the estimates set out in the First Schedule hereto AND WHEREAS it is expedient to fix the assessment at \$95,900 to take effect from 1st day of April 1967 to 31st day of March 1968 AND WHEREAS it is expedient to amend the Principal Ordinance to authorise the assessment for the year 1967/1968 NOW the Synod of the Diocese of Sydney Ordains and Directs as follows:-

1. The Principal Ordinance is hereby amended by suspending so much of the provisions of such Ordinance as are inconsistent with this Ordinance and by fixing an assessment for the purposes referred to in such Ordinance for one year from 1st day of April 1967 to 31st day of March 1968.

2. The estimates which appear in the First Schedule to this Ordinance are hereby approved and the Second Schedule of the Principal Ordinance is amended accordingly.

3. The Synod hereby fixes an amount of \$95,900 as an assessment for the period of one year from 1st day of April 1967 to the 31st day of March 1968 in accordance with the details set out in the Second Schedule hereto and the Third Schedule of the Principal Ordinance is amended accordingly.
