
Standing Orders Amendment Ordinance, 1971

No. 32, 1971

AN ORDINANCE to amend Standing Orders 9 and 64 in the rules known as Standing Orders for the conduct of all business coming before the Synod of the Diocese of Sydney.

WHEREAS rules for the conduct of business coming before the Synod are contained in the Schedule to the Standing Orders Amendment and Consolidation Ordinance 1968-1970 (hereinafter called the "Principal Ordinance") AND WHEREAS it is expedient to make further provision for the conduct of business coming before the Synod NOW the Synod of the Diocese of Sydney HEREBY ORDAINS DECLARES DIRECTS AND RULES as follows:—

1. (a) This Ordinance may be cited as "Standing Orders Amendment Ordinance 1971".
(b) The Principal Ordinance as amended by this Ordinance may be cited as "Standing Orders Amendment and Consolidation Ordinance 1968-1971".
2. Standing Order 9 contained in the Schedule to the said Ordinance is amended by omitting from paragraph (j) thereof the word "the" and by inserting in lieu thereof the words "Synod or".
3. Standing Order 64 contained in the Schedule to the said Ordinance is amended by:—
 - (a) Omitting from paragraph (1) in the third line thereof the word "the" and by inserting in lieu thereof the words "Synod or".
 - (b) Inserting next after paragraph (1) the following new paragraph:
"(1A) Every Ordinance introduced by request of Synod shall be moved by a member of Synod appointed by Standing Committee or in default of such appointment by the mover or by the seconder of the original motion in Synod requesting the presentation of such Ordinance or by some other member of Synod by leave of Synod."
