

STANDING ORDERS AMENDMENT ORDINANCE 1989

No 33, 1989

AN ORDINANCE to amend the Standing Orders Ordinance 1968.

WHEREAS by resolution 30/88 the Synod requested that the Standing Orders be amended to enable the Secretaries of Synod to give appropriate notices during the actual session of Synod.

NOW the Synod of the Diocese of Sydney HEREBY ORDAINS DECLARES AND RULES as follows.

Citation

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the "Standing Orders Amendment Ordinance 1989".

Amendment

2. Clause 7 of the Standing Orders Ordinance 1968 is amended -

(a) by inserting the matter "(1)" after the matter "7."; and

(b) by inserting the following subclause at the end of the clause -

"(2) Either of the Secretaries, with the leave of the President, may give any appropriate notices to the Synod at any time."
