

Standing Orders Ordinance Amendment Ordinance 1985

No. 1, 1985

AN ORDINANCE to amend the rules known as standing orders.

WHEREAS it is expedient to amend the Standing Orders Ordinance 1988-1984.

5 NOW the Synod of the Diocese of Sydney HEREBY ORDAINS DECLARES DIRECTS AND RULES as follows:—

1. (1) This Ordinance may be cited as the "Standing Orders Ordinance Amendment Ordinance 1985".

10 (2) The Standing Orders Ordinance 1988-1984 is hereinafter referred to as the "Principal Ordinance".

(3) The Principal Ordinance as amended by this Ordinance may be cited as the "Standing Orders Ordinance 1988-1985" and in any reprint of that Ordinance clause 3 thereof shall be amended accordingly.

15 2. The Schedule to the Principal Ordinance is amended by the insertion of the following clause after clause 4:—

~~Motions X Ordinances to Alter the Constitution 42A. An ordinance to assent to an alteration to the Constitution comprised in the Schedule to the Anglican Church of Australia Consultation Act, 1981, or to amend this proviso, shall not be considered by the Synod unless either:—~~

(a) a copy of the bill therefore shall have been sent to each member of the Synod at least three months before the first day of the session of the Synod at which the bill is to be presented; or

(b) three fourths of the members present permit the bill to be included in the agenda without further notice; and the bill shall not be read a third time unless the motion to read the bill a third time is supported by either:

(i) a majority of the lay members and of the clerical members of the Synod; or

(ii) a three fourths majority of the members of the Synod who are present.
